We've met more evocative hi-fi monikers than EAT before, but ours is not to question Euro Audio Team's name, nor its calling this 55x45cm, 44kg turntable 'Small' (as the 'S' denotes). The platter alone weighs 15kg and is partially levitated by a magnetic bearing system, with dual motors powering the smoothest possible turn. Here, it's partnered with a carbon fibre Pro-Ject Evolution tonearm and the rosewood Koetsu Red K Signature cartridge. This takes the total price to £9398. Tasty eating.
